#### DECLARATION

Know all people by these present that I, Charles J. Stinnett, do hereby declare I am the owner of the lands described in the Surveyor's Certificate, and that I have caused the same to be partitioned into parcels in accordance with the provisions of ORS Chapter 92 as shown hereon. I hereby reserve the following easement:

A private access and utility easement of variable width, over and across Parcels 1, 2 and 3, for ingress and egress, and the placement of utilities to serve Parcels 2 and 3 and also the lands shown as Parcel 1 and 2, on Land Partition No. 98—42.

SAID PARCELS ARE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING:

- 1) Rights of the public in streets, roads and highways.
- 2) Any and all matters, including easements and assessments, if any, pertaining to irrigation ditches traversing the subject property.

3) A private easement, including the terms and provisions thereof, to California—Pacific Utilities Company, a corp., dated April 9, 1974, recorded April 15, 1974, in Deed Book 111, Page 375—376, records of Grant County, Oregon. Right of way easement for utility and incidental purposes, 10 feet in width, 10 feet on the east side of the power line as it exists on the ground.

4) A private access and utility easement of variable width, to the owners of the land shown as Parcels 1, 2, and 3 on Land Partition No. 98-42, filed in the office of the Grant County Clerk.

I, Jack L. Watson, Professional Land Surveyor, registered in the State of Oregon, hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments, the parcels of this land partition. #### **NARRATIVE**

This survey was performed at the request of Charlie Stinnett. The purpose of this survey was to partition Mr. Stinnett's property, shown as Parcel 2 on Land Partition Plat No. 98—42.

After searching the available records pertaining to this survey, I found Land Partition Plat No. 98—42, which indicates that the boundary of Parcel 2 is monumented. I found and accepted the monuments as shown. The division lines of these three parcels are at positions chosen by Mr. Stinnett. I find no record of a Geodetic Control monument within 1/2 mile of this partition.
