DECLARATION

Grant County Surveyor brass cap.

Know all people by these presents that we, Floyd D. Church and Charles T. Church, do hereby declare we are the owners of the lands described in the Surveyor's Certificate, and that we have caused the same to be partitioned into parcels in accordance with the provisions of ORS Chapter 92, as shown hereon. Together with the 40 foot wide private access easement shown on Partition Plat No. 98-03 and Partition Plat No. 98-30. I also grant unto the future owners of Parcel 2 a 40 foot wide private access easement, along the south boundary of Parcel 3, of Land Partition No. 98-30, for ingress and egress to Parcel 2 of this land partition, as shown hereon.

SAID PARCELS ARE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING:

(1) Rights of the public in streets, roads and highways.

(2) Public Road Easement "A", West Bench Land Partition, including the terms and provisions thereof, executed by RLC Investments, Inc. a corp., dated January 2, 1974, recorded January 7, 1974, in deed Book 110 Page 900—905, deed records of Grant County, 60 feet in width, for ingress and egress, as shown hereon.

NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Chuck Church. The purpose of this survey was to partition Parcel 2 of Land Partition No. 96—23, and adjust the boundary between Parcel 2 of Land Partition No. 96—23 and Parcel 3 of Land Partition No. 98—30, as shown.

I found the monuments of several Land Partitions to be in place and in good condition, I accept them for the boundaries of this partition, as shown. The boundary adjustment line and the division line between parcels 1 and 2 are at positions approved by Mr. Church.

I find no record of a Geodetic Control Monument within 1/2 mile of this land partition.

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Jack Watson, Professional Land Surveyor, registered in the State of Oregon, hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments, Parcels 1 and 2 of this land partition. This is a partition of Parcel 2, Land Partition No. 96—23 and a boundary line adjustment of Parcel 3, Land Partition No. 98—30. This partition is situated in the NE1/4 of Section 28, T13S, R31E, W.M., Grant County, Oregon, described as follows:

Beginning at a 5/8" iron pin at the SW corner of Parcel 2, Land Partition No. 96–23, which I designate to be the Initial Point of this Land partition, said point being S89'59'16"W, 1047.92 feet from the E1/4 corner of Section 28,; thence N52'08'35"W, along the southerly line of Parcel 2, Land Partition No. 96–23, 497.82 feet to the easterly side line of County Road No. 74; thence 67.90 feet, along the easterly side line of County Road No. 74, on the arc of a 805.00 foot radius curve left, the long chord of which bears (N26'46'48"E, 67.88 feet); thence N24'21'49"E, along the easterly side line of County Road No. 74, 82.00 feet, to the NW corner of Parcel 2, Land Partition No. 96–23; thence S72'00'00"E, along the northerly boundary of Parcel 2, Land Partition No. 96–23, 291.04 feet; thence S46'12'51"E, along the northerly boundary of Parcel 2, Land Partition No. 96–23, 286.44 feet to the NW corner of Parcel 3, Land Partition No. 98–30, 87.50

thence S18'00'00"E, 203.64 feet to the south line of Parcel 3, Land Partition No. 98-30; thence S89'59'16"W, along the south boundary of Parcel 3, Land Partition No. 98-30 and the south boundary of Parcel 2, Land Partition No. 96-23, 295.13 feet to the point of beginning.
