

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Jack L. Watson, Professional Land Surveyor, registered in the State of Oregon, hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments, the parcels of this land partition. This is a partition of Parcel 2, Land Partition No. 99—13 situated in Gov't Lots 1 and 2 of Section 2, T14S, R31E, W.M., Grant County, Oregon, described as follows:


thence South, 329.55 feet; thence S61°00'00"W, 445.31 feet;

NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Laura Stinnett. The purpose of this survey was to partition parcel 2 of Land Partition No. 99—13 into 3 parcels.

After searching the available records pertaining to this survey, I found Land Partition Plat No. 99—13, which shows the boundaries of this partition.
