Certificate of Surveyor

I, L.E. Lucas, first being duly sworn, depose and say that I made the survey of Bennett & Lee Homesites in September, 1951, as represented on this map, that the land included within boundaries as plotted is in the NE 1/4, NW 1/4 and SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 28, T.135. N. R. 30 E. 4th W. That this map correctly represents the ground as surveyed and described, as follows: - Beginning at the Initial Point, a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe, thirty-six inches in length, driven to six inches below ground surface and marked for chaining point. Said Initial Point is 8470 feet south and 16,887 feet west from the NE 1/4 corner of above described Section 28. Thence - East 200 feet, thence S 0° 15' E 750.0 feet; Thence West 231.20 feet; Thence N 18° 15' W 307.01 feet; Thence N 0° 15' W 450.0 feet; Thence East 2750' to point of beginning.
