## Certificate of Surveyor

To J.E. Lucas, first being duly sworn and say that I made the survey of Bennett & Lee Homesites in September 1951 as represented on this map that the land in cluded within boundaries as plotted is in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 and SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 28, T. 13 S., R. 30 E., N.M. That this map correctly represents the ground as surveyed and described as follows: - Beginning at the initial point, a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe, thirty-six inches in length, driven to six inches below ground surface and marked for chaining point. Said Initial Point is 8970 feet South and 163 feet West from the NW corner of above described Section 28, Thence East 200 feet, thence  $50^{\circ} 15' E$  750 feet, thence West 230 feet, thence North  $12^{\circ} 15' W$  450 feet, thence East 2750 feet, point of beginning.


