

Certificate of Surveyor

I, L. Lucas, being first duly sworn depose and say that I made the survey of Geisler Addition as represented on this map that land included within boundaries as planned is within the SE 1/4 and SW 1/4 of section 23, T13S, R31E W.M. That this map correctly represents the ground as surveyed and described as follows:

Initial Point:- North 3240 feet from the SE corner of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 23, T13S, R31E W.M. and is an 18 inch length of three (3) inch pipe driven to within 2 inches of ground surface.

Boundaries:- Starting at the initial point, thence East 2000 feet; thence North 1400 feet; thence West 700 feet; thence South 200 feet; thence East 1400 feet; thence South 200 feet. Thence East 450 feet; to point of beginning.


