


# TRONBRIDGE SUBDIVISION

## CERTIFICATE

I, LEE LUCAS, first being duly sworn deposed and testified that the land included within boundaries as plotted on this map, that the land included within boundaries as plotted is in the NW 1/4; SW 1/4; NE 1/4 SW 1/4 and SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section T 13 S. R 3 E W.M. that this map correctly represents the ground as surveyed and described as follows:—

Beginning at the Initial Point, a  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch iron pipe, 3 ft in length, driven at a point on North bank of John Day River and East boundary of County Road, which is the SW corner of this tract, which point is 1652.7 ft North and 943.6 ft West from the SW corner of the above described Section 23, thence N 1023' W 244 ft; N 50' 13" W 536.5 ft; N 86.38' E 503.4 ft; N 770.2E 1495 ft; S 750.02E 103.5 ft; S 1023'E 200.06 ft; S 75.02'E 50.0 ft; S 64.05'E 788.4 ft; N 41.15' W 598.0 ft; N 44.018' W 499.1 ft; N 101.5' E 174.1 ft; Near 2344 ft; N 41.15' W 108.6 ft; N 1023.4' W 172.3 ft; N 750.02' W 250.0 ft to point of beginning.
