

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was established by Rufus S. Moore, US Deputy Surveyor, during the original survey Contract No. 382 dated March, 1881. Set a basalt stone 20x8x8 and made mound of stone for 1/4 sec. cor.

Description of corner evidence found:

The corner location falls in a very rocky area. Many rocks of the proper size were found, but none could be determined to be the corner stone.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2"x30" aluminum pipe with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap, marked as shown in the diagram, 22" in the ground to solid rock, at single proportionate measurements from adjacent found corners. Built a mound of rock to be 42" in diameter by 8" high around the monument, from which new BTs are:

- 10" Juniper bears N36°45'E, 32.5 feet scribed 1/4 S4 BT
- 12" Juniper bears N3°45'W, 28.9 feet scribed 1/4 S5 BT

Attached BT and Attention signs to and painted a red band around each BT. Bearings were turned from the control traverse with a theodolite, basis of bearing being the bearing between corners G-13 and N-13 as shown on Grant County Map of Survey No. 634, to stamped brass washers nailed in the scribed red-painted blazes. Distances were measured from a 60d spike, with an aluminum washer stamped PLS 699, which was driven into the side of each BT approximately one foot above the ground. Set steel fence posts 5 feet N and 5 feet E of the corner on the National Forest boundary lines. Attached Forest Boundary signs to each post and an Attention sign to the N post.

I, Leland L. Myers, P.O. Box 98, Sumpter, OR 97877, do hereby certify that on September 2/, 1989, I re-established the corner as herein described.
