

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was established by Herman D. Gradon and Bamford Robb, US Deputy Surveyors, during the original joint survey Contract No. 383 dated March, 1881.

Set basalt stone 14x12x5 for 1/4 sec. cor.

from which

- A pine 18 ins. dia. bears East, (39.6') 60 lks dist
- A pine 10 ins. dia. bears N55°W, (46.9') 71 lks dist

Description of corner evidence found:

14x12x5 stone set in a small mound of rock from which:

- 27" Ponderosa pine (26" Stump) (No Visible Scribing) (1881 BT) bears N89° 30'E, 39.8 feet.
- 17" Ponderosa pine (Good Condition) (Scribing Visible) (1881 BT) bears N56°W, 48.7 feet.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2"x30" aluminum pipe with a 3/4" aluminum cap, marked as shown in the diagram, 22" in the ground, replacing the rock which is turned upside down and buried on the north side of the monument. Improved the existing mound with rock & earth to be 24" in diameter by 8" high around the monument, from which a new BT is:

8" Ponderosa pine bears N31° 45'E, 27.0 feet scribed 1/4 S24 BT

Attached BT and Attention signs to and painted a red band around each BT. Bearings were taken with a staff compass, using a declination of 18° 30'E, to stamped aluminum washers nailed in the scribed red-painted blazes. Distances were measured from a 60d spike, with an aluminum washer stamped PLS 699, which was driven into the side of each BT approximately one foot above the ground.

Set a steel fence post 5 feet S of the corner with an Attention sign attached. The monument is not a National Forest property corner.
