

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was established by Herman D. Gradon and Bamford Robb, US Deputy Surveyors, during the original survey Contract No. 383 dated March, 1881. Set basalt stone 16x7x5 for 1/4 sec. cor.

Description of corner evidence found:

- 16x7x5 stone lying on the ground with 1/4 chisel marks.
- 24" Ponderosa pine (30" Stump) (No Visible Scribing) (1881 BT) bears S45° 15'E, 7.9 feet.
- 28" Ponderosa pine (32" Stump) (No Visible Scribing) (1881 BT) bears S51° 30'W, 27.9 feet.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2"x30" aluminum pipe with a 3/4" aluminum cap, marked as shown in the diagram, 20" in the ground to rocks, replacing the rock which is turned upside down and buried on the north side of the monument. Built a mound of rock & earth to be 36" in diameter by 10" high around the monument, from which new BTs are:

- 11" Ponderosa pine bears N10° 30'E, 30.7 feet scribed 1/4 S25 BT
- 11" Ponderosa pine bears S61° 15'W, 73.5 feet scribed 1/4 S26 BT

Attached BT and Attention signs to and painted a red band around each BT. Bearings were taken with a staff compass, using a declination of 18° 30'E, to stamped aluminum washers nailed in the scribed red-painted blazes. Distances were measured from a 60d spike, with an aluminum washer stamped PLS 699, which was driven into the side of each BT approximately one foot above the ground.

Set a steel fence post 5 feet N of the corner with an Attention sign attached. The monument is not a National Forest property corner.
