

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was established by Herman D. Gradon and Bamford Robb, US Deputy Surveyors, during the original survey Contract No. 383 dated March, 1881.

Set basalt stone 16x12x5 for 1/4 sec. cor.

A pine 14 ins. dia. bears N30°W, (24.4')37 lks dist

A pine 8 ins. dia. bears S15°E, (6.6')10 lks dist

Description of corner evidence found:

A stone of record size at the proper location from the bearing tree, but no chisel marks could be found. The rock was accepted as the corner stone.

20" Ponderosa pine (Good Condition) (Blaze Opened by Others) (1881 BT) bears S13° 15'E, 6.3 feet.

Possible stump hole at record distance and bearing for the 14" pine.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2"x30" aluminum pipe with a 3/4" aluminum cap, marked as shown in the diagram, 26" in the ground, replacing the rock which is turned upside down and buried on the north side of the monument. Built a mound of rock to be 30" in diameter by 4" high around the monument, from which a new BT is:

5" Western larch bears N71° 45'W, 32.7 feet scribed 1/4 S36 BT

Attached BT and Attention signs to and painted a red band around each BT. Bearings were taken with a staff compass, using a declination of 18° 30'E, to stamped aluminum washers nailed in the scribed red-painted blazes.

Distances were measured from a 60d spike, with an aluminum washer stamped PLS 699, which was driven into the side of each BT approximately one foot above the ground.

Set a steel fence post 5 feet W of the corner with an Attention sign attached. The monument is not a National Forest property corner.
