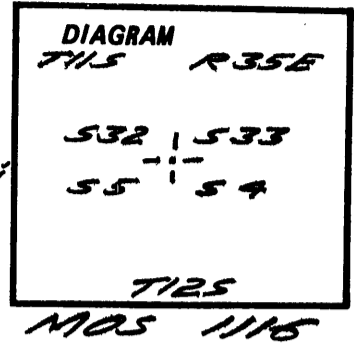


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Original corner established in 1881 by Robb & Graden.  
 Set stone 20x12x10 in stone mound from which:  
 A 12" Tamarack brs. N 78°W 26 lns.  
 A 12" Tamarack brs. N 80°E 52 lns.  
 A 12" Tamarack brs. S 65°W 49 lns.



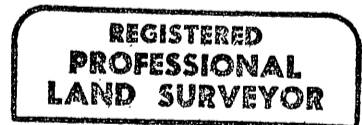
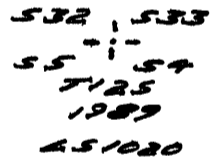
Description of corner evidence found: *Find. 18x13x11 stone with 2 marks West and 2 marks East. (East portion of stone fractured but 2 marks remain)*  
 Tamarack stump with scribes N 26°W 16.2'  
 Dead & Down Tamarack with scribes. Root hole brs. N 77°E 36.4'

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: *Set 2 1/4" x 30" aluminum pipe with 2 1/2" aluminum cap rising 8" in stone mound. Buried original stone alongside.*

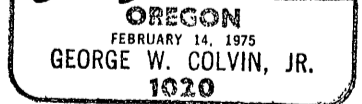
