

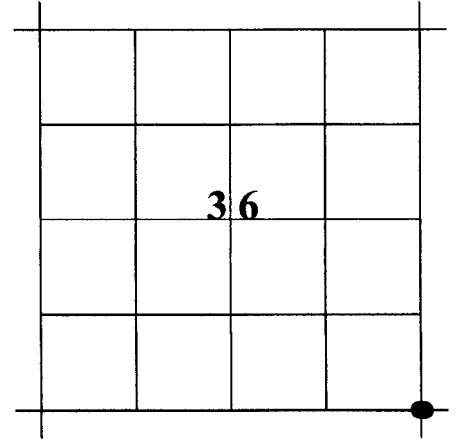

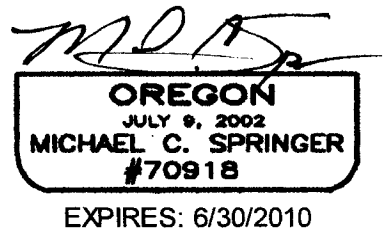

**Grant County Surveyor**

**EVIDENCE FOUND:** Found stone 11"x10"x8" in a two foot mound of stone. Stone is marked with six notches on one edge and six notches on the opposite diagonal edge. There were two juniper trees with Forest Service location posters attached near the corner and a metal "T" post driven adjacent to the mound. Remains of an old fence run East and West from the corner. A "K" tag was found in the mound dated 1962.

**AT THE CORNER POINT:** I set a 1½"x30" galvanized iron pipe with attached Grant County Surveyor brass cap, 26 inches in the ground. Placed marked stone inverted, South and along side the iron pipe. Built a 3 foot mound of stone. I left the iron "T" post in the mound. Cap marked as shown below.

**FROM WHICH I MARK THE FOLLOWING BEARING TREES:**

- A juniper 9 inch diam. bears N.69°E., 34.50 feet, marked "T13S R27E S31 CSBT".
- A juniper 8 inch diam. bears N.82°W., 10.60 feet, marked "X CSBT".
- A multi-trunk juniper, main trunk being 21 inch diam. bears N.27°W., 32.22 feet, marked "T13S R26E S36 CSBT". Attached BT tag to trees.

**ALSO FROM WHICH I SET THE FOLLOWING REFERENCE POINT:**

A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears S.27°E., 28.05 ft. with attached 1½" aluminum cap marked "GRANT COUNTY SURVEYOR RP1 2010"

Used magnetic compass with a 17° East variation and a steel tape to measure to a 50d nail driven in the side center of the root crown of the BT's and the reference point.
