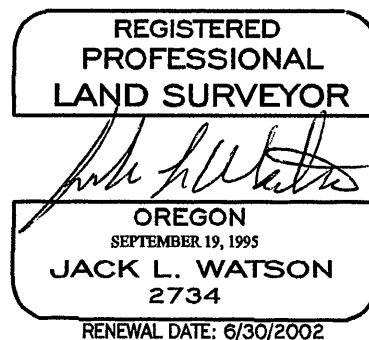


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION  
E-W 1/64 SECTION 2, T13S, R30E, W.M.

Description of monument and accessories set at corner location:

At the corner position determined by survey I found a 10" juniper tree. The center of the tree is the corner point. I scribed the south face EW1/64S2 and the north face EW1/64S35.

From which:

An 8" Juniper bears S46°E, 17.3 feet, marked EW1/64S2BT.

An 10" Juniper bears N2°W, 28.9 feet, marked EW1/64S35BT.

I used a steel tape measuring to a 50d nail driven in the side center at the root crown of the BT's and magnetic compass, with 18° E. declination.
