

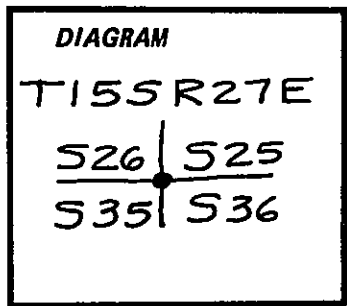
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Samuel W. Lackland, Deputy Surveyor, under G.L.O. Contract No. 384 dated March 29, 1881.

Surveyor General's records state:

North between Secs. 35 & 36 VA 18°45'E
80.00 Set basalt stone 18X10X7 in. mound of stone for Cor to Secs 25, 26, 35 & 36 from which a Pine 45 in. dia. bears S58°E 60 Lks (39.60 ft.) dist.

Description of corner evidence found:

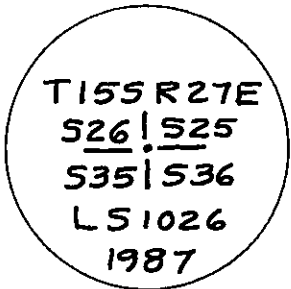
At assumed corner location found basalt stone 18"X10"X7" firmly set 8 inches in ground in SE side of 3-1/2 foot diam. stone mound consisting of approx. 12 other large stones. Original stone marked with one notch on SE edge and one north on NE edge. Found remains of original BT, a 48" dead & down windfall Ponderosa Pine, badly rotted, with visible scribing - S36T15R28BT - on pitch face slab, bears South 51° East, 39.6 ft. to approx. face location.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of original stone, set 2-1/2 inch O.D. X 30 inches long aluminum pipe 18 inches in ground to bedrock with 3 inch aluminum cap marked as shown:

Marked bearing trees:

- A 10" Ponderosa Pine bears North 71-1/4° East, 17.0 ft., scribed-T15SR27ES25BT;
- An 8" Juniper bears South 27-1/4° East, 12.8 ft., scribed-T15SR27ES36BT;
- A 6" Juniper bears South 70-1/4° West, 27.7 ft., scribed-T15SR27ES35BT;
- A 9" Ponderosa Pine bears North 13-1/4° West, 29.4 ft., scribed-T15SR27ES26BT.



M.V.19-1/2°E.

Deposited original stone ^{NORTH} of cap and raised stone mound 3 foot diam. to cap. Set steel post 5 feet South with sign 54-4 facing cap. Painted red band and faces red and nailed signs 54-3 and 54-4 to BT's. Nailed brass washer stamped "AS&E LS1026" to face of BT's. East-South wire fence corner is 4 ft. South and 7 ft. West of cap.

I hereby certify that the above corner monument was re-established as herein described on May 7, 1987.
