

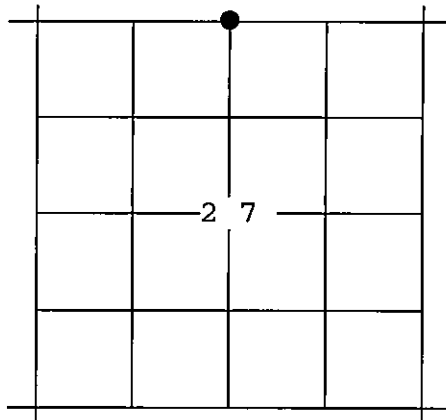

ORIGINAL DESCRIPTION:

Set post for 1/4 Sec. Cor. from which
 A pine 12" diam., bears N.60°E., 40 lks. dist.
 A pine 14" diam., bears S.40°E., 55 lks. dist.
 I did not find the original post in 1975, I established the corner at
 record distances from the two found original BT stumps. My record states:

Set a 1 1/2"x30" iron pipe 26" in the ground with brass cap marked as shown;
 from which I SCRIBE NEW BEARING TREES:
 A 9" pine bears S78°E., 3.7 feet, scribed 1/4 S27 CSBT.
 A 13" pine bears N7°W., 44.6 feet, scribed 1/4 S22 CSBT.

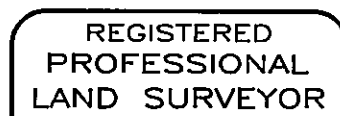

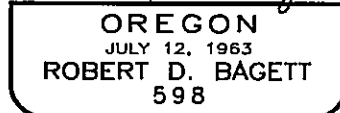

EVIDENCE FOUND: Found a 1 1/2" iron pipe with a 2 1/2" Grant County Surveyor brass cap marked as shown below.

From which:
 A pine 12"diam., bears S78°E, 4.3 ft. with partially healed over blaze, scibing visible.
 A pine 17"diam., bears N7°W, 44.9 ft. with completely healed over blaze.
 Distances measured to center of BTs.
 Corner is 2' west of corner of fences running North, South, East.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES SET AND METHODS USED:

Show how trees are scribed and basis of bearings, including compass var.

The monument set in 1975 is in good condition.
