

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was established by S. W. Lackland, US Deputy Surveyor, during the original survey Joint Contract No. 357 dated July, 1880.

Set post for cor Secs 27, 28, 33 & 34 with pits and mound as per instruction.

Description of corner evidence found:

Logging, fence building and grazing activities have all contributed to the loss of original corner evidence. A cruiser tag is on a large pine NW of the corner, but it does not have any distance or bearing to a corner on it. There is a three-way fence corner about 40' SW of the corner.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2"x30" aluminum pipe with a 3 1/4" aluminum cap, marked as shown in the diagram, 24" in the ground to rock, at double proportionate measurements from adjacent found corners. Built a mound of rock & earth to be 30" in diameter by 6" high around the monument, from which new BTs are:


- 17" Ponderosa pine bears N77° 45'E, 53.2 feet scribed T16SR30E S27 BT
- 13" Ponderosa pine bears South, 91.6 feet scribed T16SR30E S34 BT
- 18" Ponderosa pine bears S60° 30'W, 68.2 feet scribed T16SR30E S33 BT
- 11" Ponderosa pine bears N76°W, 78.7 feet scribed T16SR30E S28 BT

Attached BT and Attention signs to and painted a red band around each BT. Bearings were taken with a staff compass, using a declination of 18° 30'E, to stamped brass washers nailed in the scribed red-painted blazes. Distances were measured from a 60d spike, with an aluminum washer stamped PLS 699, which was driven into the side of each BT approximately one foot above the ground.

Set steel fence posts 5 feet S and 25 feet W of the corner on the National Forest property lines. Attached Forest Boundary signs to each post and an Attention sign to the S post.

I, Leland L. Myers, P.O. Box 98, Sumpter, OR 97877, do hereby certify that on June 3, 1986, I re-established the corner as herein described.
