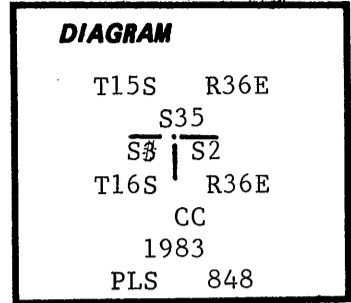


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established in 1881 by Henry W. Cooke, Under General Land Office Contract No. 422. Surveyor Generals Notes State: Intersect 3rd standard South 20.34 chs. East of standard cor. to secs. 34 & 35, T15S R36E at which point of intersection I set a basalt stone 16 x 9 x 4 ins. 11 ins in ground. For closing cor. secs 2 & 3 marked with CC on E & 6 notches on S edges.

- A Pine 48 ins diam. bears N52°W 45 lks. dist marked T15S R36E S35EBT.
- A Pine 42 ins. diam. bears S86°W 37 lks. dist. marked T16S R36E S3 BT.
- A Pine 36 ins diam. bears S55°E 137 lks. dist. marked T16S R36E S2 BT.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found 24" x 10" x 5" stone with 6 notches on South face & CC on East face set 14" in the ground.

From which:

- A Pine 29" dia. live in good condition with scribing visible bears S80°W, 24.3 ft.
- A Pine with scribing visible bears S55°E, 90 ft.
- A Pine 30" dia. dead & down (pushed over) fits record reasonable well. Accepted stone as the original position of the closing corner as set by H. W. Cooke. This position is used to establish alignment & moved S 0° 05' 07" E, 30.71 ft. to a true intersection with the 3rd standard parallel South.

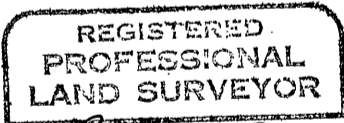
Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 30" x 2" aluminum pipe with a 3½" aluminum cap stamped as shown in diagram.

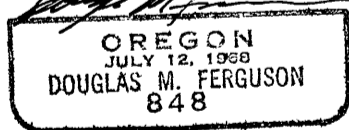
Set 8" in the ground & raised a mound of stone around pipe.
Set original stone West alongside pipe.

From which:

- A Fir 13" dia. bears S27°E, 22.8 ft. scribed T16S R36E S2 EC.BT.
- A Pine 12" dia. bears S43°W, 69.8 ft. scribed T16SSR36E S3 CC BT.
