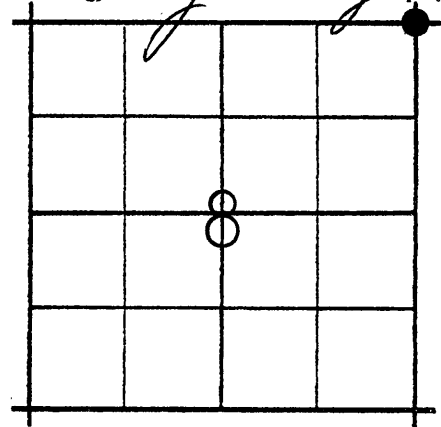

ORIGINAL DESCRIPTION:

80.00 Set a pine post  $4\frac{1}{2}$  ft long 4" square with marked stone 12 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 4, 5, 8, & 9 marked S4 on NE, R28E S9 on SE, S8 on SW and S5 on NW faces, from which  
A pine 48 ins diam bears S1°E, 202 lks. dist mkd. T17S R28E S9 BT.  
A pine 36 ins. diam., bears S25°W 203 lks. dist., mkd. T17SR28E S8 BT  
dug pits in secs. 4 and 5, 18x18x12 ins. and raised a mound of earth 2 ft high  $4\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base around post.

EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found both original BTs. Both are dead and down. There is no remains of the corner post or the stone.

I established the corner at record distance from the old BTs.

FROM THE CORNER POINT, THE ORIGINAL BTs:

A 50" pine, dead and down bears S1°E., 133.3 ft. mkd. T.17S R28E S9 BT.  
A 40" pine, dead and down bears S25°W, 134.0 ft. mkd. T17S R28E S8 BT.

This corner is about 70 feet North of a East-West fenceline.

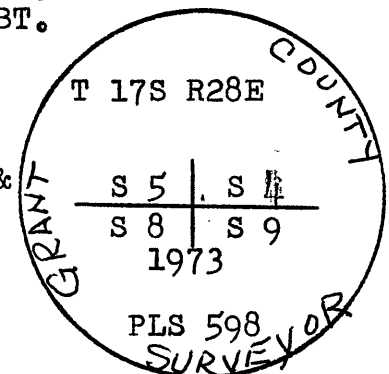
DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES SET AND METHODS USED:

Show how trees are scribed and basis of bearings, including compass var.

Set  $1\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" iron pipe, 25" in the ground with brass cap marked as shown, from which NEW BEARING TREES:

A 12" pine bears N79°E, 14.6 ft., mkd. T17S R28E S4 BT. MONUMENT MARKED  
A 10" pine bears S67°E, 29.2 ft., mkd. T17S R28E S9 BT.  
A 8" pine bears S14°W, 36.1 ft., mkd T17S R28E S8 BT.  
A 14" juniper bears N88°W 29.00ft., mkd.  
T17S R28E S5 BT.

Used a compass with 20° East var. and a steel tape & measured to the face of the blaze on the new BTs.
