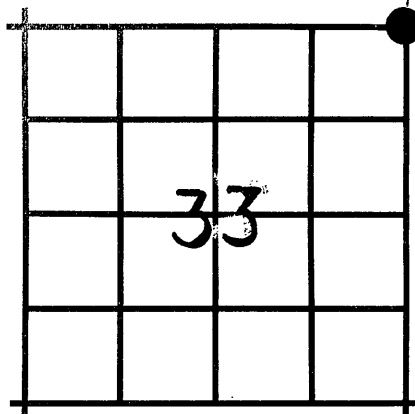


# CORNER RESTORATION

**ORIGINAL DESCRIPTION:** G.L.O. RECORD: North between Sections 33 and 34  
 80.00 chains. Set basalt stone 18x14x12 inches,  
 12 inches in ground. Marked with 1 notch on South  
 and 3 notches on East and raised a mound alongside.

**EVIDENCE FOUND:**

I found a basalt stone 18x12x10 inches, marked with  
 3 grooves on East face and 1 groove on North face, laying on its side  
 where it tipped over. I accept the position of this stone for the  
 section corner.

**DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES SET AND METHODS USED:**

Show how trees are scribed and basis of bearings, including compass var.

In place of the corner stone, I set a 1½"x30"  
 galvanized iron pipe 22 inches in the ground with brass  
 cap marked as shown:

From which I scribe NEW BEARING TREES:

- A Juniper 14 ins. diam. bears N. 57½° W., 673.5 ft.,  
 mkd. T17SR28ES28 CSBT.
- A Juniper 6 ins. diam., bears S. 22° W., 121.5 ft.,  
 mkd. X CSBT.

No other trees within reasonable distance. Buried original  
 stone East and alongside the iron pipe, and surrounded  
 pipe with mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top of cap. Bearings  
 based on solar observation and distances measured with electronic  
 distance measuring device, measuring to the head of a 40d nail driven  
 flush with the BT blaze at root crown of BT's. Attached Grant  
 County Surveyor BT tags to BT's and painted blazes with red timber  
 marking paint. This corner is NE about 1500 ft. from the intersection  
 of County Road No. 63 and County Road No. 68.
