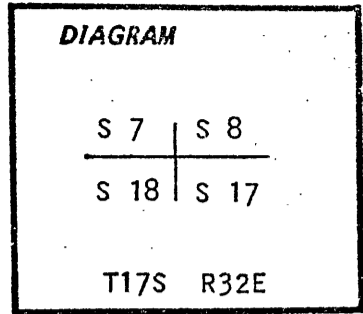
**History of original corner establishment:**

Corner established in 1884 by Henry W. Cooke under General Land Office contract #494

Surveyor General record states;

Set basalt stone 16x14x10 ins. for cor. marked with 4 notches on the S and 4 notches on the E edges from which;

- A Pine 36 ins. diam. bears N24E, 145 lks.
- A Pine 36 ins. diam. bears S48E, 160 lks.
- A Pine 48 ins. diam. bears S80W, 92 lks.
- A Pine 48 ins. diam. bears N20W, 173 lks.



No record of subsequent remonumentation was found in the County records

**Description of corner evidence found:**

Found marked stone 16x12x9 inches in mound of stone and 4 BTs

**Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:**

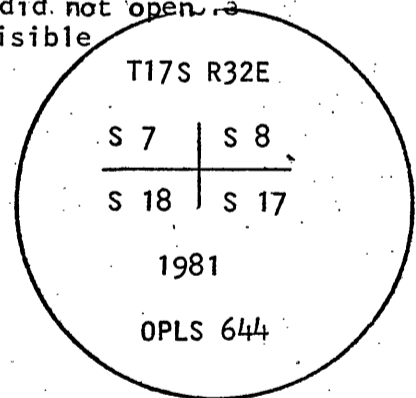
In place of stone I set a 2½ x 30 inch aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 26 inches in the ground from which;

**ORIGINAL BTs**

- A 36 inch P.Pine stump bears N24E, 96.0 feet, scribes visible
- A 36 inch P.Pine stump bears S46E, 105.6 feet, scribes visible
- A 40 inch P.Pine bears S80W, 60.7 feet, dead and down, did not open
- A 40 inch P.Pine stump bears N20W, 114.0 feet, scribes visible

**NEW BTs**

- A 11 inch P.Pine bears N56E, 21.5 feet, marked T17S R32E S8 BT
- A 14 inch P.Pine bears S67E, 14.4 feet, marked T17S R32E S17 BT
- A 8 inch P.Pine bears S47W, 13.3 feet, marked X BT
- A 10 inch P.Pine bears N34W, 12.2 feet, marked T17S R32E S7 BT



Buried stone East and alongside of pipe

Date, September 13, 1981.

Brass washer nailed to BT blaze. Used steel tape and magnetic compass with 21° East declination in the establishment of accessories. Original BTs measured to face of blaze. New BTs measured to center of tree.
