CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

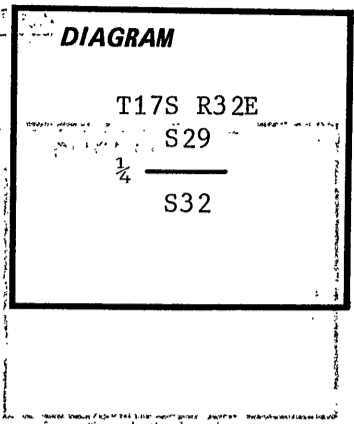
**History of original corner establishment:**

The original corner was established in 1884 by Henry W. Cooke.

Set a basalt stone 16x8x8 ins, 10 ins in the ground for 1/4 sec cor. marked 1/4 on the N. face from which

A pine 36 ins diam bears S 34 E 70 lks dist marked 1/4SBT.

A pine 30 ins diam bears N 32 W 95 lks dist marked 1/4SBT.



**Description of corner evidence found:**

Found a 19x6x5 stone, firmly set, marked 1/4 on the North face, in a mound of stone.

A 30" Ponderosa Pine bears N 31 1/2 W, 63.4 feet scribed 1/4S in an opened face.

**Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:**

Set a 3 1/4"x30" aluminum monument with magnet 22" in the ground in a mound of stone.

12" Ponderosa Pine bears S 77-3/4 W, 18.8 feet scribed 1/4S32BT.

Bearing trees have a 3/4" brass washer marked LS 1918 attached between the B & T. Bearing tree measurements were made to the center of the tree. Painted faces and bands red and attached Attention signs and BT tags.

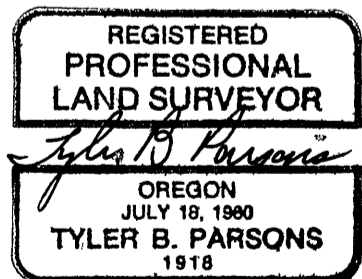
