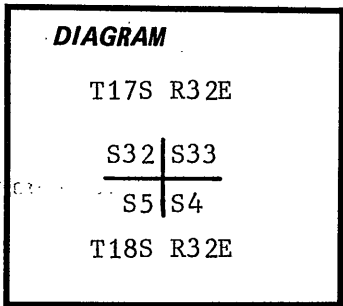


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

The original corner was established by Henry W. Cooke in 1883.

Set basalt stone 16x12x7 ins. 10 ins in the ground for cor to secs 4,5,32 &33. marked with 4 notches on the E. and 2 notches on the West edges. dug pits in each sec 5½ ft dist and raised a mound of earth 2 ft high 4½ ft base alongside.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 19x11x7 stone, firmly set, with 2 grooves on the West face and 4 grooves on the East face, in a mound of stone.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 3¼" x 30" USDA aluminum monument with magnet 22" in the ground in a mound of stone. Placed the original stone in the mound.

CAP MARKED

15" Ponderosa Pine bears N 50½ E, 206.8 feet scribed T17SR32E S33BT, with a 3/4" brass washer attached between the B & T. Painted face and band red on the BT and attached Attention sign and BT tag. Measured to the center of the BT.

Set a 2" aluminum cap on rebar S 45 E, 25.0 feet stamped

Set a 2" aluminum cap on rebar S 45 W, 25.0 feet stamped

T18S R32E S5 RM N45E 25.0 PLS 1918 1985.

Set a 2" aluminum cap on rebar N 45 W, 25.0 feet stamped

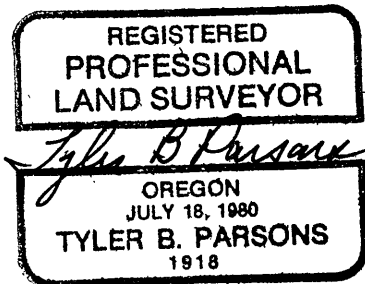
T17S R32E S32 RM S45E 25.0 PLS 1918 1985.

Set a steel fence post with Attention sign West 3 feet.
