

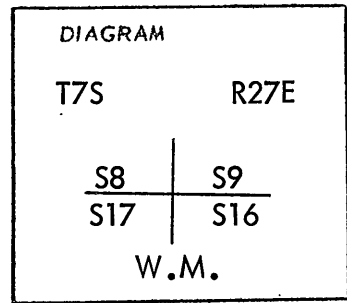
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Index No. J-9

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Frank W. Campbell under Contract No. 521 dated January 8, 1885. The original notes state that a basalt stone 15" x 10" x 4" was set 10" in ground with 4 notches on south and east edges from which:

- A 15" pine bears N 38° E, 172 Lks (113.5 ft) marked T7S R27E S9BT
- An 18" pine bears S 72° E, 44 Lks (27.0 ft) marked T7S R27E S16BT
- A 15" pine bears S 72° W, 11 Lks (7.3 ft) marked T7S R27E S17BT
- A 14" pine bears N 12° W, 70 Lks (46.2 ft) marked T7S R27E S8BT



No record of subsequent remonumentation found in County Records .

Description of corner evidence found:

- Found mound of stones, could find no markings on stones from which:
- A 20" pine with partially healed blaze and scribing visible bears N 10½° W, 46.5 feet.
 - A down and rotted 20" pine bears S53° W 9.9 feet ±, laying on blaze.
 - A 27" pine stump with bottom of blaze visible bears N 39½° E, 113.5 feet.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the corner position a 2 inch by 30 inch iron pipe, with brass cap marked as shown, was set 18 inches in the ground and surrounded with a mound of stones to the cap .
 Set steel fence post south of corner and attached signs 54-2 and 54-4.
 Established 3 new BT's:
 A 12' red fir bears S 60° W, 24.6 feet, scribed T7S R27E S17BT
 A 13½" bull pine bears N 81½° E, 20.9 feet, scribed T7S R27E S9BT
 An 18" bull pine bears S 18½° E, 91.5 feet, scribed T7S R27E S16BT
 Used old BT: A 20" pine bears N 10½° W, 46.5 feet
 New BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush.
 Attached signs 54-3 and 54-4 to all BT's and painted red ring around the trees above the upper blaze.

Used steel tape and magnetic compass with 19½° east declination . Measured to center of Bts.
 See map of survey.

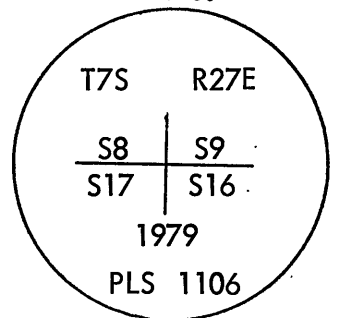
