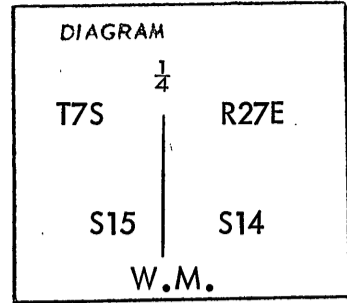


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Index No. L-17

History of original corner establishment:

This corner originally established by Frank W. Campbell under Contract No. 521 dated January 8, 1885. The original notes state that a basalt stone 14" x 10" x 5" was set 9" in the ground, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on west face, from which:
A 30" pine bears S 78° E, 42 Lks (27.7 feet) scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ SBT
A 7" pine bears N 73° W, 36 Lks (24.8 feet) scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ SBT



No record of subsequent remonumentation found in County Records .

Description of corner evidence found:

Found stone 14" x 12" x 5" set 6" in ground with $\frac{1}{4}$ marked on west face barely visible, from which:
A 34" pine stump 6' high bears S 82° E, 29.1 feet to center with scribing visible BT.
Rotted 7" pine scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT stump hole bears N 75° W (24.8 feet).

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the corner position a 2 inch by 30 inch iron pipe, with brass cap marked as shown, was set 18 inches in the ground and surrounded with a mound of stones to the cap.

Set a steel post north of corner and attached 54-4 sign.

Established 2 new BT's:

A 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " red fir bears N 83° W, 17.1 feet scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S 15 BT

A 15" red fir bears S 58 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E, 28.5 feet scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S 14 BT

New BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush.

Attached signs 54-3 and 54-4 to all BT's and painted red ring around trees above upper blaze.

Used steel tape and magnetic compass with 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° east declination . Measured to center of Bts.

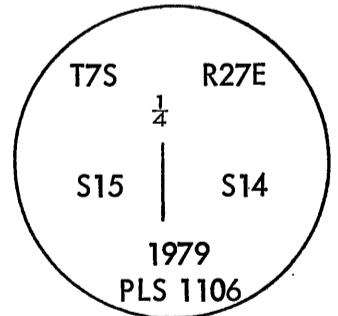
