

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Refer to: Plat of Wilson 1985 Cadastral Survey
Section 29, T.7S., R.27E., W.M.

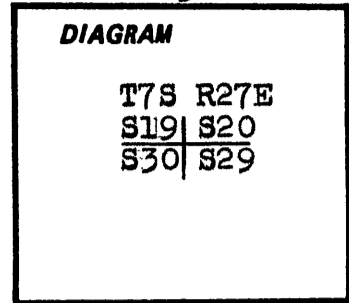

History of original corner establishment:

Frank W. Campbell, under G.L.O. contract number 521, dated Jan. 8, 1885, set a basalt stone 12"X 8"X 6" eight inches in the ground. Stone marked with 2 notches on south edge and 5 notches on east edge.

From the corner:

- A Pine, 12" dia., N70°E, 34 lks.
- A Pine, 12" dia., S40°E, 14 lks.
- A Pine, 8" dia., S21°W, 30 lks.
- A Pine, 8" dia., N78°W, 30 lks.



Description of corner evidence found:

I found a stone 11"X 10"X 5" with no marks visible. From the corner:

- A Ponderosa Pine, 19" dia., N77°E, 22.5 ft.; with a healed blaze.
- A Ponderosa Pine; down, burned and rotted; with scribing visible; the root hole of which bears S44°E, 9 ft.
- A Ponderosa Pine; down and rotted; with scribing visible; the butt of which bears S28°W, 16 ft. (unable to find root hole)
- A Ponderosa Pine; down and rotted; with scribing; the butt of which bears N69°W, 20.5 ft. (unable to find root hole)

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the original corner point I set a 2 1/2"X 30" alum. pipe with a 3" alum. cap containing a magnet and marked:

I buried the original stone alongside.

From the corner:

- A Ponderosa Pine, 16" dia., S55 1/2°E, 62.1 ft.
marked: T7S R27E S29 BT
- A Douglas Fir, 9" dia., S40 3/4°W, 13.3 ft.
marked: T7S R27E S30 BT
- A Douglas Fir, 10" dia., N51 1/2°W, 14.4 ft.
marked: T7S R27E S19 BT

BTs have blaze and a 6" stripe painted red, a BT tag, an "Attention" sign and an alum. "PLS 1832" washer nailed to the bottom of the blaze. There is a 6' steel fence post with an "Attention" sign within 5' of the corner.

Measured to center of BTs using steel tape and staff compass. Magnetic declination set at 18 1/2°E
