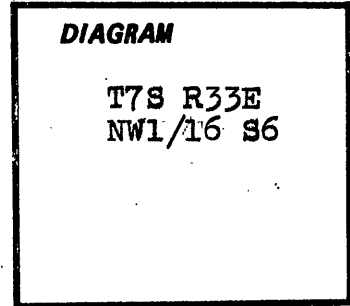


**CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION**

At the corner point established by measurement, I set a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" alum. pipe with a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " alum. cap marked:  
Monument is 17" in the ground and surrounded by a mound of stone.

A Ponderosa Pine, 19" dia., S39 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 99.0 ft.; marked: NW1/16 S6 BT  
A Ponderosa Pine, 16" dia., S58°E, 14.4 ft.; marked: NW1/16 S6 BT

BTs have blaze and a 6" band painted red, BT tags, "Land Survey Monument" signs and alum. "PLS 1832" washers nailed to the bottom of the blaze. There is a 6' steel fence post with a "Land Survey Monument" sign within 5' of the corner.

Measured to center of BTs using steel tape and staff compass. Magnetic declination set at 18°E..
