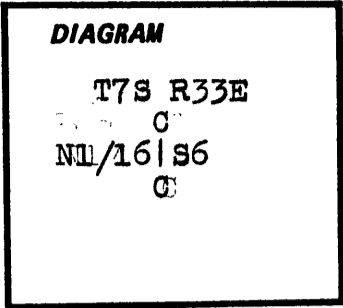

At the corner point established by measurement, I set a 2¹/₂" x 30" alum. pipe with a 2¹/₂" alum. cap marked:

A Ponderosa Pine, 16" dia., S28 3/4°E, 28.6 ft.; marked: C N1/16 S6 BT
A Ponderosa Pine, 14" dia., S74 1/2°W, 14.9 ft.; marked: C N1/16 S6 BT

BTs have blaze and a 6" band painted red, BT tags, "Land Survey Monument" signs and alum. "PLS 1832" washers nailed to the bottom of the blaze. There is a 6' steel fence post with a "Land Survey Monument" sign within 5' of the corner.

Measured to center of BTs using steel tape and staff compass. Magnetic declination set at 18°E.
