

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

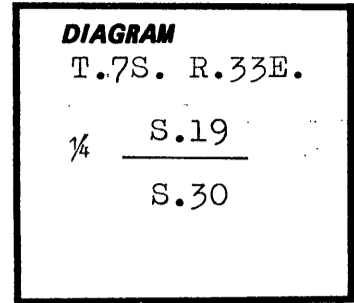
**History of original corner establishment:**

Corner was first established by William R. Gradon in 1885 under Contract No. 519, dated October 2, 1884.

Set a post 3½' long, 3" square, 24" in the ground, at Corner.

14" Diam. Tamarack, N.48°W., 28 lks., mkd., 1/4SBT.

14" Diam. Tamarack, S.44°E., 9 lks., mkd., 1/4SBT.



**Description of corner evidence found:**

Corner post gone.

Original 14" diam. Tamarack, N.48°W., 28 lks., dead and down, with scribes 4S visible.

Original 14" diam. Tamarack, S.44°E., 9 lks., felled, with scribes 1/4SBT visible.

**Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:**

Set a 2½" diam. Brass cap in a 2" X 30" iron pipe at average bearing and distance from B.T.'s.. Cap mkd. per sketch. Set steel posts with mon. and attn. signs attached, 4'±, E. & W. of Corner.

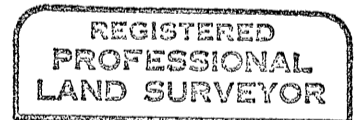
8" D.B.H. Douglas Fir, N.37½°E., 40.2', scribed 1/4S19BT.
