

History of 1974 BLM Remonumentation

The cor. of secs. 9 and 16 only, on the W. bdy. of the Tp., determined at record bearing and distance from the remains of the original bearing trees:

A lodgepole pine, 11 ins. diam., bears S. 35° E., 31 lks. dist., with scribe marks T7S R35 $\frac{1}{2}$ E S16 BT visible on open double blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
