

History of 1974 BLM Remonumentation

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. sec. 16 only, on the W. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with the original basalt stone, 14 x 12 x 6 ins., firmly set 5 ins. in the ground, mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face, from which the remains of the original bearing trees:

A lodgepole pine, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 85° E., 25 lks. dist., with healed double blaze.

A lodgepole pine, 23 ins. diam., bears S. 70° W., 175 lks. dist., with healed double blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

from which new bearing trees

A lodgepole pine, 4 ins. diam., bears East, °117 lks. dist., mkd. X BT

A lodgepole pine, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 53° E., 113 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S16 BT.

Bury the corner stone alongside iron post.
