

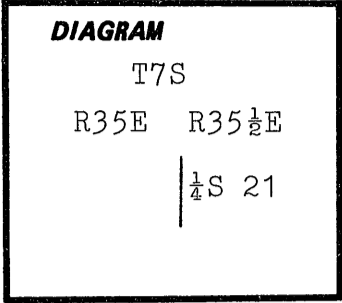
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

The corner was originally established by Eugene McCornack under Contract No. 398 dated July 2, 1882.

The original notes state that at the corner a 12" by 12" by 12" basalt stone; marked 1/4 on west face was set 8" in the ground from which:

- A 8" pine bears S40°E-121ks marked 1/4 S BT.
- A 10" pine bears S60°W-171ks marked 1/4 S BT.



No record of subsequent remonumentation was found in county records.

Description of corner evidence found:

None. Corner was reestablished by single proportion measure between the West ¼ corner of Section 16 and the Southwest corner of Section 21, utilizing record distance measurements recorded for the junior Gradon survey corners found at the East ¼ of Section 24 and the Southeast corner of Section 24.

This corner was searched for 9 hours including 3½ hours of PLS time. A stone mound bears S 13 3/4°E-137'- origin unknown.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the corner position a 2 1/2" by 30" aluminum pipe with 2 1/2" aluminum cap was set 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth from which:

- A 6" l.p. pine bears S 89½°E-22.6' scribed 1/4S 21 BT.
- A 9" white fir bears S 71½°E-69.3' scribed 1/4S 21 BT.

Each new bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of the blaze. Attached signs 54-3 and 54-4 and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree.

Set steel fence post with sign 54-4 attached next to the monument.

Used steel tape and magnetic staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on June 4, 1984.

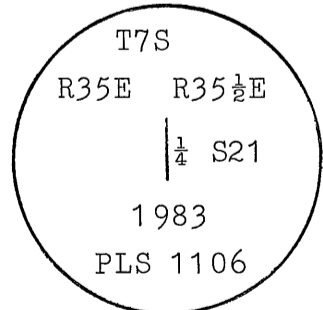
