

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Herman D. Gradon, under contract No. 499 dated March, 1884.

The original notes state that at the corner:

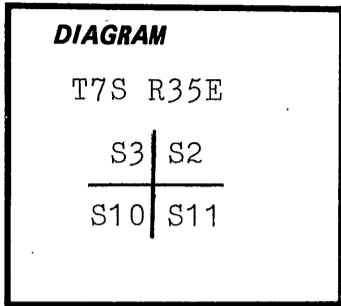
A 4 in. square by 4 ft. marked post set 24 in. in the ground for the corner, from which:

A 7 in. dia. Pine bears N26°E - 19 lks (12.5 ft.) marked: T7S R35E S2 BT

A 8 in. dia. Pine bears S63°E - 18 lks (11.9 ft.) marked: T7S R35E S11 BT

A 7 in. dia. Pine bears S75°W - 19 lks (12.5 ft.) marked: T7S R35E S10 BT

A 10 in. dia. Pine bears N36°W - 11 lks (7.3 ft.) marked: T7S R35E S3 BT



No subsequent record of remonumentation was found in County records.

Description of corner evidence found:

A 8 in. dia. Pine snag (long butted stump, 6 ft. tall) bears S63°E - 18 lks (11.9 ft.) with visible scribing, T7S R35E S11 BT.

Corner was re-established by bearing-distance from found bearing tree.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set: A 2½ in. by 30 in. aluminum pipe, with a 2½ in. aluminum cap, 26 in. in the ground with a mound of stone to the cap, from which:

- A 7½ in. dia. Fir bears N35°E - 42.4 ft., scribed: T7S R35E S2 BT BT
- A 9 in. dia. Spruce bears S8°E - 31.5 ft., scribed: T7S R35E S11 BT BT
- A 8½ in. dia. Fir bears S87½°W - 81.7 ft., scribed: T7S R35E S10 BT BT
- A 9 in. dia. Spruce bears N52°W - 72.3 ft., scribed: T7S R35E S3 BT BT (double blaze)

Each new bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of the lower blaze, and has 54-3 and 54-4 signs attached. The face of the blaze and a 6 in. band around each bearing tree are painted red.

Set a steel fence post, with 54-4 sign attached, North of the monument.

Used a steel tape and a magnetic staff compass, with 20° East declination. Measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was monumented on September 1, 1983.

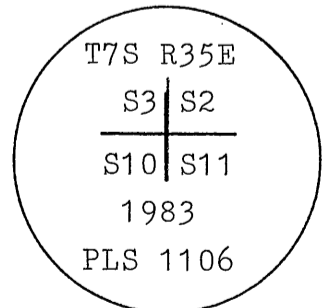
