

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

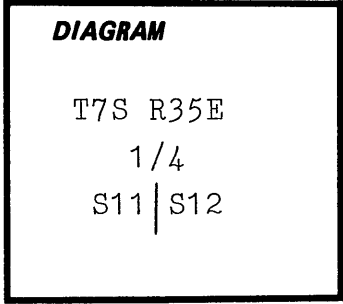
Corner established by Herman D. Gradon, under contract No. 499 dated March, 1884.

The original notes state that at the corner:

A 3 in. square by 3 ft. marked post, set 24 in. in the ground for the corner, from which:

A 5 in. dia. Pine bears N35°E - 16 lks (10.6 ft.) marked: 1/4 S BT

A 6 in. dia. Pine bears N85°W - 16 lks (10.6 ft.) marked: 1/4 S BT



No record of subsequent remonumentation was found in County records.

Description of corner evidence found:

None

This corner was established as part of a subdivisional section breakdown survey, using the single proportion method between two found corners, being the Northeast and Southeast corners of section 11.

Spent 8 manhours (3 hours PLS time) searching a 300 ft. radius around corner position. Corner falls in thicket of small Lodgepole 4 in. to 10 in. sizes. The area has been heavily burnt 60+ years ago. Older trees in the area are heavily burnt and are rotting on the ground.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set: A 2 1/2 in. by 30 in. aluminum pipe, with a 2 1/2 in. aluminum cap, 22 in. in the ground with a mound of stone to the cap, from which:

- A 7 in. dia. Lodgepole Pine bears S29°E - 15.0 ft., scribed: 1/4 S12 BT
- A 6 in. dia. Lodgepole Pine bears S68 1/2°W - 9.3 ft., scribed: 1/4 S11 BT

Each new bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of the blaze, and has 54-3 and 54-4 signs attached. Painted the face of the blaze and a 6 in. band around each bearing tree red.

Set a steel fence post, with 54-4 sign attached, South of the monument.

Used a steel tape and a magnetic staff compass, with 20° East declination. Measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was monumented on September 14, 1983.

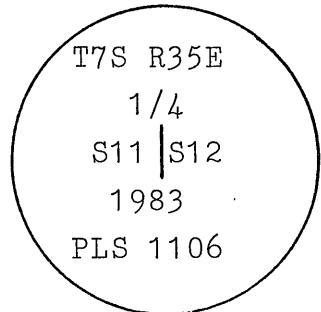
