

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

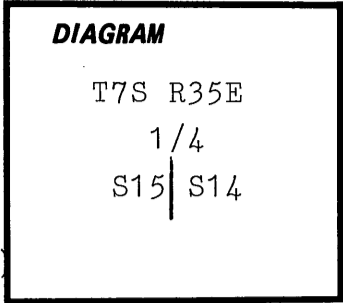
Corner established by Herman D. Gradon, under contract No. 499 dated March, 1884.

The original notes state that at the corner:

A 3 in. square by 3 ft. marked post, set 24 in. in the ground for the corner, from which:

A 10 in. dia. Pine bears S40°E - 121 lks (79.9 ft.) marked: 1/4 S BT

A 8 in. dia. Pine bears S20°W - 110 lks (72.6 ft.) marked: 1/4 S BT



No record of subsequent remonumentation was found in County records.

Description of corner evidence found:

A 17 in. dia. Lodgepole Pine snag bears S35°E - 121 lks (79.9 ft.) with open blaze and visible scribing.

A 19 in. dia. Lodgepole Pine snag bears S12°W - 110 lks (72.6 ft.) with healed blaze.

Reset corner by distance-distance intersection between the two found bearing trees.

Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set: A 2 1/2 in. by 30 in. aluminum pipe, with a 2 1/2 in. aluminum cap, 27 in. in the ground, from which:

A 17 in. dia. Spruce bears S39°E - 79.9 ft., scribed: 1/4 S14 BT

A 10 in. dia. Lodgepole Pine bears S46 1/2°W - 127.5 ft., scribed: 1/4 S15 BT

Each new bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of the blaze, and has 54-3 and 54-4 signs attached. Painted the face of the blaze and a 6 in. band around each bearing tree red.

Set a steel fence post, with a 54-4 sign attached, North of the monument.

Used a steel tape and a magnetic staff compass, with 20° East declination. Measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was monumented on September 12, 1983.

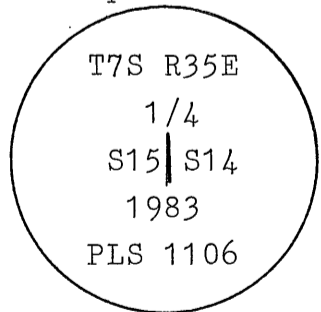
