

History of 1974 BLM Remonumentation

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. sec. 13 only, on the E. bdy. of T. 7 S., R. 35 E., determined at record bearing and distance from the remains of the original bearing trees:

A decayed lodgepole pine stump, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 81° W., 44 lks. dist., with a down lodgepole pine log alongside, 12 ins. diam., with scribe marks $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT visible on open double blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

A lodgepole pine, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 70° W., 15 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S13 BT.

A lodgepole pine, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 17° W., 12 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S13 BT.
