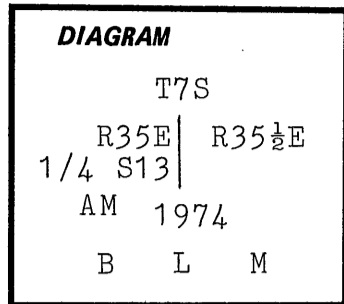


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Amended Monument



History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Herman D. Gradon, under contract No. 499 dated March, 1884.

The original notes state that at the corner:

A 3 in. square by 3 ft. marked post, set 24 in. in the ground for the corner, from which:

A 12 in. dia. Pine bears N66°W - 36 lks (23.8 ft.) marked: 1/4 S BT

A 12 in. dia. Pine bears S81°W - 44 lks (29.0 ft.) marked: 1/4 S BT

For history of 1974 BLM remonumentation, see attached sheet.

Description of corner evidence found:

A 3¼ in. brass cap on an iron pipe, protruding 12 in. out of the ground, with a mound of stone, set by BLM in 1974, marked as per diagram, from which:

A 12 in. l.p. Pine snag bears N17°W - 12 lks (7.9 ft.) with visible scribing.

A 13 in. dia. Lodgepole Pine bears S70°W - 15 lks (9.9 ft.) with visible scribing.

A 12 in. dia. down s.p. Pine bears S81°W - 44 lks (29.0 ft.) with visible scribing.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

A 6 in. dia. Lodgepole Pine bears N71°W - 2.5 ft., scribed: 1/4 S13 BT

New bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of the blaze. Attached 54-3 and 54-4 signs, and painted the face of the blaze and a 6 in. band around each bearing tree red.

Set steel fence post North of the monument with sign 54-4 attached.

Used a steel tape and a magnetic staff compass, with 20° East declination. Measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was maintained on September 15, 1983.
