

History of 1974 BLM Remonumentation

The cor. of secs. 13 and 24 only, on the E. bdy. of T. 7 S., R. 35 E., determined at record bearing and distance from the remains of the original bearing trees:

A lodgepole pine, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 65° W., 58 lks. dist., with scribe marks T7S R35E S24 BT visible on open double blaze.

A decayed lodgepole pine stump, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 28° W., 8 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on decayed blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 14 ins. in the ground and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

A lodgepole pine, 7 ins. diam., bears N. 60° W., 50 lks. dist., mkd. T7S R35E S13 BT.
