

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

**History of original corner establishment:**

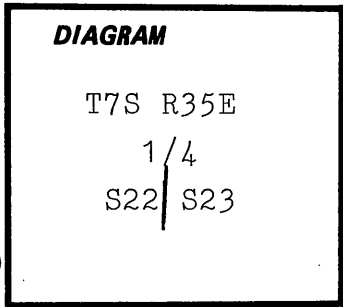
Corner established by Herman D. Gradon, under contract No. 499 dated March, 1884.

The original notes state that at the corner:

A 3 in. square by 3 ft. marked post, set 24 in. in the ground for the corner, from which:

A 8 in. dia. Pine bears S47°E - 16 lks (10.6 ft.) marked: 1/4 S BT

A 8 in. dia. Pine bears N25°W - 20 lks (13.2 ft.) marked: 1/4 S BT



No record of subsequent remonumentation was found in County records.

**Description of corner evidence found:**

A 9½ in. dia. Pine snag bears N25°W - 20 lks (13.2 ft.) with visible scribing - 1/4 S BT (double blaze).

Corner was re-established by bearing-distance intersect from found bearing tree.

**Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:**

Set: A 2½ in. by 30 in. aluminum pipe, with a 2½ in. aluminum cap, 18 in. in the ground with a mound of earth to the cap, from which:

A 8 in. dia. Fir bears S88°E - 5.4 ft., scribed: 1/4 S23 BT

A 10½ in. dia. Fir bears S42°W - 29.7 ft., scribed: 1/4 S22 BT

Each new bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of the blaze, and has 54-3 and 54-4 signs attached. Painted face of blaze and a 6 in. band around each bearing tree red.

Set a steel fence post, with 54-4 sign attached, North of the monument.

Used a steel tape and a magnetic staff compass, with 20° East declination. Measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was monumented on September 7, 1983.

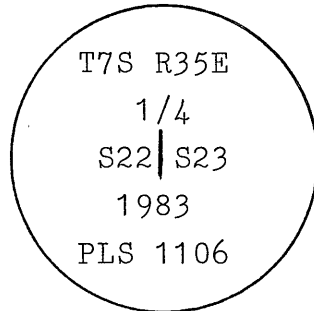
