

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Amended Monument

History of original corner establishment:

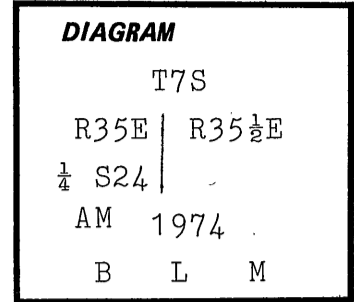
Corner established by Herman D. Gradon, under contract No. 499 dated March, 1884.

The original notes state that at the corner:

A 3 in. square by 3 ft. marked post, set 24 in. in the ground for the corner, from which:

A 8 in. dia. Pine bears S40°E - 12 lks (7.9 ft.), marked: 1/4 S BT

A 10 in. dia. Pine bears S60°W - 17 lks (11.2 ft.), marked: 1/4 S BT



For history of 1974 BLM remonumentation, see attached sheet.

Description of corner evidence found:

A 3¼ in. brass cap on an iron pipe, protruding 6 in. from the ground, set by BLM in 1974, marked as per diagram, from which:

A 23 in. l.p. pine snag bears N29°W - 12.5 ft., with open blaze and visible scribing.

A 8 in. l.p. pine bears N49°W - 151 lks (99.7 ft.), with visible scribing.

A 13" down l.p. pine bears S50°W-97 lks (64.0 ft.) with visible scribing.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Attached 54-3 and 54-4 signs to bearing trees. Painted face of blaze and a 6 in. band around each bearing tree red.

A reference monument bears West - 12.00 ft., marked: S24 12.00 ft. PLS 1106

Reference monument is a 5/8 in. iron pin with 1½ in. aluminum cap. Set steel fence post with sign 54-4 next to reference monument.

Set a steel fence post, with 54-2 and 54-4 signs attached, West of monument.

Used a steel tape and magnetic staff compass with 20° East declination. Measured to center of bearing trees.

This corner was maintained on September 15, 1983.
