

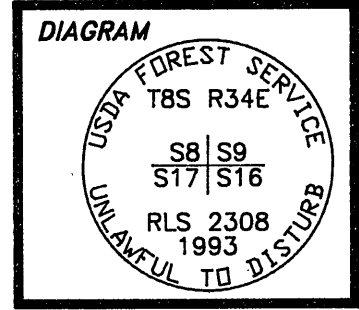
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

1884, HERMAN D. GRADON, UNDER CONTRACT NO. 499, ESTABLISHED THE CORNER. HE SET A POST 4' LONG & 4" SQUARE, 24" IN THE GROUND, FROM WHICH:
15" FIR, N. 55° E., 26 LINKS.
8" PINE, S. 38° E., 19 LINKS.
16" TAMARACK, S. 66° W., 40 LINKS.
6" PINE, N. 74° W., 37 LINKS.

1993, DAVID A. SCHLAICH, RLS 2308, FOUND THE SW BT AND SET AT RECORD BEARING AND DISTANCE A 2 1/2" BY 30" ALUMINUM PIPE, WITH 3 1/4" ALUMINUM CAP, 20" IN THE GROUND, FROM WHICH:
20" WESTERN LARCH, S. 66° W., 26.4 FEET (40 LKS.), WITH HEALED BLAZE CHOPPED OPEN TO REVEAL SCRIBING (ORIGINAL BT).
MARKED NEW BT'S:
8" DOUGLAS FIR, N. 30° E., 24.1 FEET.
15" DOUGLAS FIR, S. 9° E., 34.7 FEET.
7" LODGEPOLE PINE, N. 82° W., 26.9 FEET.



Description of corner evidence found:

FOUND A 2 1/2" ALUMINUM PIPE, WITH 3 1/4" ALUMINUM CAP, PROJECTING 10" OUT OF THE GROUND, MARKED AS SHOWN (SEE DIAGRAM), FROM WHICH:

8" DOUGLAS FIR, N. 30° E., 24.1 FEET, SCRIBING "T8S R34E S9" BT" VISIBLE ON A DOUBLE BLAZE (1993 BT).
15" DOUGLAS FIR, S. 9° E., 34.7 FEET, SCRIBING "T8S R34E S16" BT" VISIBLE ON A DOUBLE BLAZE (1993 BT).
20" WESTERN LARCH, S. 66° W., 26.4 FEET, WITH HEALED BLAZE CHOPPED OPEN TO REVEAL SCRIBING (ORIGINAL BT).
7" LODGEPOLE PINE, N. 82° W., 26.9 FEET, SCRIBING "T8S R34E S8" BT" VISIBLE ON A DOUBLE BLAZE (1993 BT).

THE 1993 BT'S HAVE A 3/4" BRASS WASHER STAMPED "RLS 2308" NAILED TO THE LOWER BLAZE BETWEEN THE "BT" SCRIBING.
