

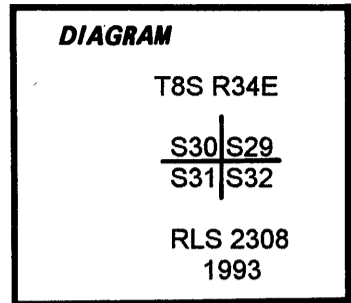
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

V-5

History of original corner establishment:

1884, Herman D. Gradon, under contract No. 499, established the corner. He set a basalt stone 14" by 10" by 6", 9" in the ground, from which:

- 15" Fir bears, N. 40° E., 20 lks.
- 24" Fir bears, S. 47° E., 59 lks.
- 13" Fir bears, S. 77° W., 36 lks.
- 22" Fir bears, N. 80° W., 54 lks.



Description of corner evidence found:

At the corner point I found a broken basalt stone, approximate size 14" by 10" by 6", with no marks, from which:

- 36" Douglas Fir snag bears, S. 43 1/2° E., 59 lks. (38.9 feet), with healed blaze.
- 31" Douglas Fir snag bears, S. 80 1/4° W., 36 lks. (23.8 feet), with no marks visible.
- 32" Douglas Fir bears, N. 77° W., 54 lks. (35.6 feet), with double healed blaze.
- Root hole bears, N. 40° E., 20 lks. (14.2 feet).

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I replaced the stone with a 2 1/2" by 30" aluminum pipe, with 3 1/4" aluminum cap, set 16" in the ground and placed a 2' diameter by 1' high rock mound around the monument, with the original broken stone placed at the bottom of mound.

Marked New BT's:

- 45" Western Larch bears, N. 55 1/2° E., 33.8 feet, marked "T8S R34E S29" "BT".
- 10" Englemann Spruce bears, S. 22 3/4° E., 9.5 feet, marked "T8S R34E S32" "BT".
- 10" Lodgepole Pine bears, S. 31 1/2° W., 28.0 feet, marked "T8S R34E S31" "BT".

The new BT's are double blazed and have a brass washer stamped "RLS 2308" nailed to the lower blaze by the "BT" scribing.

Magnetic Declination 20° East.
