

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

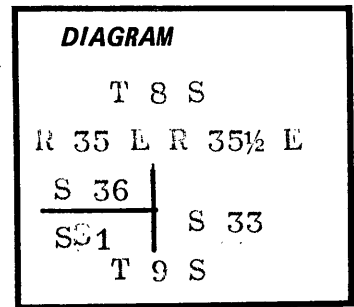
History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Herman D Gradon under G.L.O. contract No. 499 dated March 11, 1884.

Surveyor General records state:

Set a basalt stone 18 X 12 X 10 ins 12 ins in the ground for the cor to Tps 8 and 9 S R 35 E marked with 6 notches on the N, S, and W edges from which:

- A pine 30 ins diam bears S 76° W, 52 lks dist mkd T 9 S R 35 E S 1 BT
- A fir 6 ins diam bears N 45° W, 43 lks dist mkd T 8 S R 35 E S 33 BT



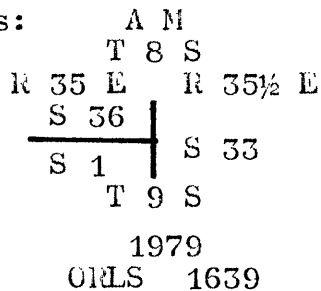
Description of corner evidence found:

- A dead pine about 30 ins diam (windfall) for section 1 bearing tree with no visible scribes.
- A sawed stump for section 36 bearing tree with BT scribes visible.
- At the record position found a basalt stone with 6 grooves on N, S, and W edges in a mound of stone.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

As per advisory letter No. 9641.5 (942) from the Chief, Branch of Cadastral Survey, Oregon State Office, B.L.M. and the 1973 Manual of Survey Instruction Sec 5-35 (paragraph 3) and Sec 5-41 (paragraph 3) I set a 2½ inch brass cap on a 2 inch iron pipe 31 ins long, 26 ins in the ground with a 6 ft steel fence post 3 ft west with sign 54-4 attached. This monument is re-established at the intersection of a line extended between the south quarter corner of sec 36 T 8 S R 35 E and the found stone with the W line of the SW quarter of sec 33 T 8 S R 35½ E, WM. (The original stone was buried at its original position, 3.67 ft W of brass cap).

Brass cap marked thus:



New bearing trees:

- A pine 11 ins diam bears S 89° W, 53.5 ft dist marked T 9 S R 35 E S 1 BT
- A fir 9 ins diam bears N 44° W, 29.3 ft dist marked T 8 S R 35 E S 36 BT

Lach BT has a sign 54-3 attached below a band of red paint and has a brass washer marked LS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.

I hereby certify the above corner was properly re-established on June 13, 1979 witnessed by Tracy Labaree and Tom Fisk.
