

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Corner originally established by Eugene P. McCornack under contract No. 398 dated July 1881.

Set post 4 ft. long 4 ins square 24 ins in the ground for Cor to Secs 7, 12, 13 and 18 marked

T8SS7 on NE

R36ES18 on SE

R35½E S13 on SW and

S12 on NW faces with two notches on the N and 4 notches on the S edges from which

A Black Pine 7 ins diam bears N60 E 23 lks dist marked T8SR36ES7 B.T.

A Black Pine 6 ins diam bears S25 E 12 lks dist marked T8SR36ES18 B.T.

A Black Pine 8 ins diam bears S25 W 23 lks dist marked T8SR35½ES13 B.T.

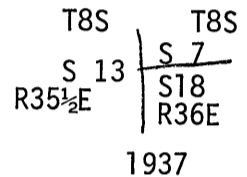
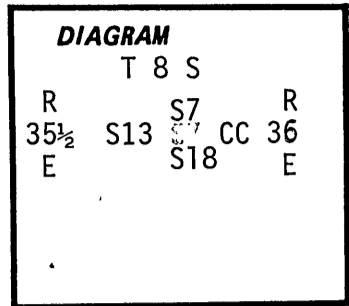
A Black Pine 8 ins diam bears N30W 16 lks dist marked T8SR35½ES12 B.T.

The corner was resurveyed by Otis O. Gould under Group No. 179 dated July 1937.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 7 and 18, with brass cap marked from which

A pine 10 ins diam. bears N. 60 E., 50 lks. dist., marked T8SR36ES7CC BT.

A tamarack, 40 ins. diam., bears S. 54 E., 91 lks. dist., marked T8SR36E S18 CC BT.

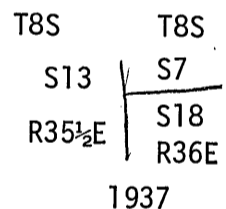


Description of corner evidence found:

At the corner location I found Gould's brass cap marked as shown below, in good condition, from which

A dead pine bears N60 E, 50 lks. dist., marked BT.

A live 40" tamarack bears S54 E, 91 lks. dist., with healed over blaze.



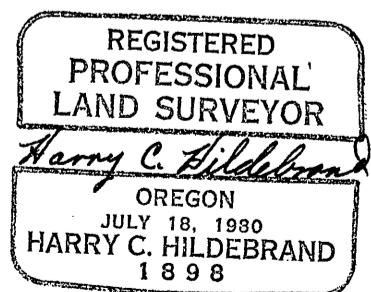
Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: From the brass cap I set two new bearing trees.

A 9" Western larch bears N63 E, 28.97 ft. dist. marked T8SR36ES7CCBT. Nail in S. base

A 12" fir bears N84 W, 23.77 ft. dist. marked T8SR35½ES13CCBT. Nail in N. base.

Bearings taken with staff compass declination 18½ East per 1980 Isogonic chart.

Distances pulled to 60d nails with brass washers stamped LS 1898 driven into side center of bearing trees.
