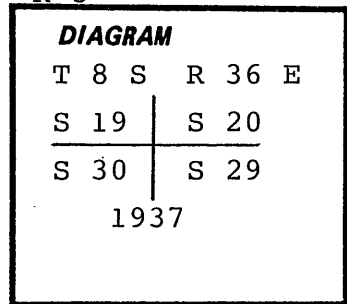


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

R-5

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Otis O. Gould under special instructions dated Nov. 27, 1935, which provided for the surveys included under Group No. 179.



Surveyor General records state:

Set an iron post 3 ft long 2 ins diam 24 ins in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to top for cor of secs 19, 20, 29, and 30 with brass cap marked (as shown in corner diagram) from which:

- A spruce 36 ins diam bears N48°E, 41 lks dist marked T8SR36ES20 BT.
- A fir 18 ins diam bears S35°E, 41 lks dist marked T8SR36ES29 BT.
- A spruce 8 ins diam bears S43½°W, 31 lks dist marked T8SR36ES30 BT.
- A pine 14 ins dia bears N33°W, 29 lks dist marked T8SR36ES19 BT.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 2½" brass cap on 1" iron pipe protruding 10" from mound of earth marked as shown in corner diagram.

- A down dead spruce 24 ins diam bears N51°E, 27.1 ft (record states: N48°E)
- A fir 17 ins dia bears S35°E, 27.3 ft with open blaze and visible scribes.
- A spruce 9½ ins dia bears S39°W, 19¾ft with healed blaze (record states: S43½°W, 31 lks)
- A pine 14 ins dia bears N33°W, 19°ft with open blaze and visible scribes.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Corner monument maintained to USFS standards as follows...cleared brush and debris from around cor monument. Placed 6' steel fence post E of cor with sign 54-9 attached.

New bearing tree established:

- A spruce 10 ins dia bears N31½°E, 28¾ft marked T8SR36ES20 BT.
- Each original bearing tree and each new bearing tree has signs 54-3 and 54-9 attached below a 6 inch band of red paint, additionally each new bearing tree has a brass washer marked PLS 1106 nailed flush with BT blaze.
- Compass declination 19°East.

I hereby certify that the above corner monument was properly maintained to U.S.F.S. standards under my supervision and witnessed by Willard Hulick on August 2, 1986.
