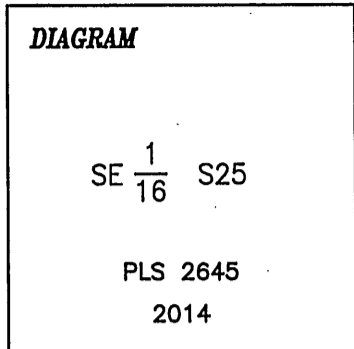


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 3" x 30" aluminum pipe with a 3 1/4" aluminum cap marked with a magnet in a clear plastic case was deposited at the base of pipe. Cap is 4" above the ground.



New accessories:

A 8" Douglas Fir scribed "X" & "BT" with a aluminum tag marked "2645" bears N22°30'E, 35.0'.
A 15" Ponderosa Pine scribed "SE 1/16 S25 BT" with alum. tag marked "2645" bears N75°45'W, 33.6'.
