

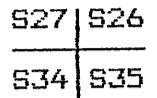
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was established by Rufus S. Moore, US Deputy Surveyor, during the original survey Contract No. 382 dated March, 1881.

Set a basalt stone 14x12x12 and erected mound of stone for cor. to sec's. 26, 27, 34, 35

Description of corner evidence found:

The corner location was on an open grassy hillside. A careful search in the computed corner location turned up a rock 13x11x10 which was accepted as the corner stone, but no markings were found.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2"x30" aluminum pipe with a 2 1/4" aluminum cap, marked as shown in the diagram, 18" in the ground to solid rock, replacing the rock which is turned upside down and buried on the north side of the monument. Built a mound of rock to be 36" in diameter by 12" high around the monument, from which new BTs are:

- 7" Juniper bears S23°15'W, 116.1 feet scribed T9SR31E S34 BT
- 16" Juniper bears N62°W, 414.9 feet scribed T9SR31E S27 BT
- 18" Ponderosa pine bears N4°E, 408.6 feet scribed T9SR31E S26 BT

Attached BT and Attention signs to and painted a red band around each BT. Bearings were turned from the control traverse with a theodolite, basis of bearing being the bearing between corners G-13 and N-13 as shown on Grant County Map of Survey No. 634, to stamped brass washers nailed in the scribed red-painted blazes. Distances were measured from a 60d spike, with an aluminum washer stamped PLS 699, which was driven into the side of each BT approximately one foot above the ground. Set steel fence posts 5 feet W and 5 feet S of the corner on the National Forest boundary lines. Attached Forest Boundary signs to each post and an Attention sign to the W post.

I, Leland L. Myers, P.O. Box 98, Sumpter, OR 97877, do hereby certify that on November 19, 1989, I monumented the corner as herein described.
