

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was established by Herman D. Gradon, US Deputy Surveyor, during the original survey Joint Contract No. 416 dated August, 1881.

Set a basalt stone 12x12x8 ins 8 ins in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 on W. face; from which

A pine 38 ins dia bears S45°E, (56.8') 186 lks dist. marked 1/4 S BT
No other tree within limits and raise a stone mound alongside.

Description of corner evidence found:

12x11x9 stone marked 1/4 on south face with top of stone to east in a ring of stones.

43° Ponderosa pine (Fair Condition) (Blaze Opened by Others) (1881 BT) bears S43° 30'E, 57.0 feet

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2"x30" aluminum pipe with a 3 1/4" aluminum cap, marked as shown in the diagram, 24" in the ground to rock, replacing the rock which is turned upside down and buried on the north side of the monument. Built a mound of rock to be 30" in diameter by 6" high around the monument, from which a new BT is:

19° Ponderosa pine bears S7°W, 211.9 feet scribed 1/4 S15 BT

Attached BT and Attention signs to and painted a red band around each BT. Bearings were taken with a staff compass, using a declination of 18° 30'E, to stamped brass washers nailed in the scribed red-painted blazes.

Distances were measured from a 60d spike, with an aluminum washer stamped PLS 699, which was driven into the side of each BT approximately one foot above the ground.

Set steel fence posts 5 feet N and 5 feet S of the corner on the National Forest property lines. Attached Forest Boundary signs to each post and an Attention sign to the N post.
