

**CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION**

**History of original corner establishment:**

Corner was established by Herman D. Gradon, US Deputy Surveyor, during the original survey Contract No. 416 dated August, 1881

Set a basalt stone 16x8x6 ins. 11 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 on W face and raised a mound of stone alongside.

**Description of corner evidence found:**

Corner location falls in scab rock opening. Nearby N-S fence is supported by rock jacks about every other post. No evidence of the original corner stone was found.

**Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:**

Set a 2"x30" aluminum pipe with a 3 1/4" aluminum cap, marked as shown in the diagram, 18" in the ground to rock, at single proportionate measurements from adjacent found corners. Built a mound of rock to be 34" in diameter by 12" high around the monument, from which new BTs are:

15" Ponderosa pine bears N32° 30'W, 57.6 feet scribed 1/4 S22 BT

13" Ponderosa pine bears N30° 45'E, 103.3 feet scribed 1/4 S23 BT

Attached BT and Attention signs to and painted a red band around each BT. Bearings were turned from the control traverse with a theodolite, basis of bearing being a solar observation, to stamped brass washers nailed in the scribed red-painted blazes. Distances were measured from a 60d spike, with an aluminum washer stamped PLS 699, which was driven into the side of each BT approximately one foot above the ground.

Set steel fence posts 5 feet S and 5 feet N of the corner on the National Forest property lines. Attached Forest Boundary signs to each post and an Attention sign to the S post.

I, Leland L. Myers, P.O. Box 98, Sumpter, OR 97877, do hereby certify that on August 17, 1986, I re-established the corner as herein described.
