

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was established by Herman D. Gradon, US Deputy Surveyor, during the original survey Contract No. 416 dated August, 1881.

Set a basalt stone 16x8x6 ins. 11 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 on W face; from which

- A pine 10 ins dia bears S74°E, (14.5')22 lks dist marked 1/4 S BT
- A pine 40 ins dia. bears N85°W, (61.4')93 lks dist marked 1/4 S BT

Description of corner evidence found:

The corner location falls in an area of heavy logging activity and lots of rocks on the ground. Could not find any evidence of the original corner. 10" pine and 40" pine (1881 BTs) not found.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2"x30" aluminum pipe with a 3 1/4" aluminum cap, marked as shown in the diagram, 24" in the ground to rock, at single proportionate measurements from adjacent found corners. Built a mound of rock to be 32" in diameter by 6" high around the monument, from which new BTs are:

- 11" Ponderosa pine bears S86° 45'E, 13.9 feet scribed 1/4 S25 BT
- 9" Ponderosa pine bears S17°W, 10.6 feet scribed 1/4 S26 BT

Attached BT and Attention signs to and painted a red band around each BT. Bearings were turned from the control traverse with a theodolite, basis of bearing being a solar observation, to stamped brass washers nailed in the scribed red-painted blazes. Distances were measured from a 60d spike, with an aluminum washer stamped PLS 699, which was driven into the side of each BT approximately one foot above the ground.

Set a steel fence post 5 feet N of the corner with an Attention sign attached. The monument is not a National Forest property corner.

I, Leland L. Myers, P.O. Box 98, Sumpter, OR 97877, do hereby certify that on July 30, 1986, I re-established the corner as herein described.
